### A Bill to Propose Constitutional Amendments

---

#### Bill History

The current version of the University of Colorado Student Government (CUSG) Constitution was last updated on April 12, 2018. As a document for an organization that seeks excellence in serving the student body, the Constitution must undergo regular revision to meet its stated mission.

#### Bill Summary

This bill proposes amendments to the CUSG Constitution for the consideration of the voting student body in the Spring 2020 Election.

**Whereas**, in order to be most accessible and applicable to the student body, the CUSG Constitution is in need of revision.

**Whereas**, the change from Advisory to Joint Board status for the Center for Student Involvement and the Volunteer Resource Center will ensure the role of the

students' voice in the governance of these student fee-funded cost centers in the years to come.

**Whereas**, the establishment of an Advisory Board for the CUSG student-fee funded cost center: the office of Off-Campus Housing and Neighborhood Relations will assist the office in developing new programs and plans to support students who live off-campus.

**THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Boulder Student Government, THAT:**

**Section 1:** The proposed changes to each section of the CUSG Constitution contained in Appendix A of this bill, shall be proposed to the voters as a single amendment revision to the CUSG Constitution in the Spring 2019 Election.

**Section 2:** The question to be placed on the ballot for consideration of the voters for this amendment shall be:

“Should the University of Colorado Student Government (CUSG) Constitution be amended to modernize CU Student Government systems, move the Center for Student Involvement and Volunteer Resource Center from advisory to joint board status, and establish an advisory board for the Off-Campus Housing and Neighborhood Relations Office?”

**Section 3:** This bill shall take effect upon final passage by the Legislative Council and upon either obtaining the signatures of two Executives or the lapse of six days without actions by the Executives.
